Treasurer Report (Alicia Rempel):

- \$15,000 rolled over
- Gaming depleted to \$800 which will roll over
- \$5000 contingency rolled over every year
- \$12,000 for playground fund, next year able to purchase new equipment
- Nothing in restricted funds
- Profit and loss significant money is for hot lunch, just over \$16,000 in sales
- Munch a lunch \$4000 in parent credits
- Plant fundraiser not logged yet
- Last installment of story walk \$3700 out of gaming account now paid in full
